

# Rock Garden Caterpillar

## Materials

- Disposable brushes in various sizes
- Rocks
- Craft paint (if your caterpillar will be sitting outside use an outdoor paint)
- E6000 (or similar glue to hold the rocks together)
- Twigs for the antennae
- Sharpies (or you could use paint to draw on the faces)

## Directions

1. Paint your rocks.
2. Draw the face on your caterpillar's "head."  
*Tip: Pull out your hair dryer to make the drying time go faster. If making the garden rock caterpillar with children, they love to use the dryer on their own!*
3. Assemble the caterpillar after the paint has properly dried!  
*Tip: This is another great time to pull out the hairdryer. Prop up as much of the caterpillar as you can and then give it a shot with the dryer. It will help it be more secure and dry faster.*
4. Attach the "antennae" (sticks) with your waterproof glue.
5. Let your whole caterpillar dry and cure overnight.
